

## Patterns Over Time

We are tracking the prevalence of condom use over time. West Virginia observed a **decrease** from 2003 to 2023.<sup>†</sup> The United States observed a **decrease** from 2003 to 2023.<sup>††</sup>



Missing data point indicates that data were not available.

† Overall, the percentage of students reporting this behavior decreased from 2003 to 2023. The direction of the trend line did not change from 2003 to 2023. Any indicated increase or decrease is statistically significant.
